As we do the Spirit breathes life and transformation into our inner being. Spending time in his presence, resting in his delight, listening and responding to his voice characterize this pursuit.

Fairhaven guests are increasingly sharing stories of responding to Jesus' invitation with purposeful engagement. This is our story. This is our mission . . . encouraging the health and renewal of Christian leaders.

This has been another time of refreshing and rest in this perfect setting. We are so blessed to have been able to come.
