



Thank you for considering a Fairhaven. Retreats here on the mountain are a wonderful opportunity to unplug and experience the silence and solitude of our setting. It is our prayer that guests will experience the renewing presence of Jesus during their stay.

A few key considerations in preparation for your reservation request:

- Reservations **must be in compliance with BC Provincial Health Orders current at the time of the reservation.**
- If you or someone in your party has tested positive for CoVid 19 within 5 days of your arrival, we ask that you reschedule your visit to allow for a period of recovery. Please see the **Counselling and Retreat Fees** schedule for our cancellation policy.
- In the event you are experiencing symptoms consistent with CoVid19 during your stay, we ask that you monitor your interaction with other guests and where possible use appropriate preventative measures (physical distancing, intentional hygiene, and use of masks).
- The main Lodge is open for guest use. Current open hours will be stated on the Welcome sheet enclosed in your packet upon arrival. **The use of masks is no longer required when entering the Lodge, with the exception noted immediately above.**
- For the health and safety of our guests and staff, **on-site visitors require prior approval. Additional charges apply for overnight stays.**

These precautionary measures are being taken to limit the potential spread of the CoVid-19 virus and its variants, to support our guests and staff alike during this time, and to ensure we maintain our capacity to tangibly fulfill the mission of encouraging the health and renewal of Christian leaders.

We are excited that Fairhaven can be an oasis in the midst of the all too familiar din of anxiety and fear gripping our world; a safe space where physical and spiritual rest can facilitate peace and increased awareness of Jesus' abiding presence.
